Application Process:

The applicant must submit the following items (by e-mail or mail):

- Completed application form (hand written in blue or black ink) and Essay (typed)
- A copy of the most recent high school or college transcript
- A copy of proof of acceptance of student enrollment from a college or university (when available)
- Recipients will be required to participate on a face to face or electronic interview

Application Deadline:

The application must be received or postmarked by July 1st (Fall Semester) or December 1st (Spring Semester). **Incomplete applications and applications received after deadline will not be considered.**
